## **Our session descriptors**

**Learning Through Play:** A session to encourage children's independence and confidence through sharing play ideas and learning opportunities. These sessions are themed around a story or a song. This session is for children aged 0-5 years.

Learning Through Play (With a focus on Let's get ready for nursery and school): Through carefully planned, playful opportunities, these sessions will help you and your child to strengthen and develop key skills which will help them in their journey to becoming lifelong learners.

Rhyme Time: A song and rhyme session to support children's early communication skills. Session includes sharing songs, music and rhymes that are brought to life using different props that the Early Years Educators have to engage young minds. This session is for children aged 0–5 years

Stay and Play for Under 1's: This session aims to support developing babies to grow and learn. Activities will encourage babies to reach their developmental milestones, following their interests and curiosities.

**Little Explorers:** A sensory and messy play session providing materials of differing textures, temperatures, and consistencies for children to explore, supporting their development and growing confidence.

Learning Together Babies: Learning Together offers a variety of activities as well as a Talk Time, songs and stories to support children's development, by building their confidence as they learn to explore.

Mini Childrens Library: Borrow a book to take home. All books come with a puppet, story prop or musical instrument.
