Every three months, we listen to your concerns and look at recent crime statistics to shape the things we will concentrate on for the next three months. Our priorities for the next quarter are:

Speeding – Over the past month we have further listened to community concerns regarding speeding and

have carried out speed checks in various locations across Gainsborough Rural South, engaging and taking appropriate action with motorists.

Theft of Motor Vehicles - There has been an increase in thefts from and of Transit Vans, Range Rovers and Land rovers. If anybody has any concerns or questions regarding security of their vehicles, please get in touch.

WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING

Delivery Service Scams- We are currently receiving several reports relating to delivery scams, phishing emails and texts that have been circulated pretending to be from DPD, Royal Mail and Amazon. These emails and texts claim that you have missed a delivery and ask you to reschedule for a small fee, thereby obtaining your bank details.

Reporting - If you have received an email which you are not quite sure about, forward it to the Suspicious Email Reporting Service (SERS) at report@phishing.gov.uk.

If you have received a suspicious text message, forward it to 7726. It won't cost you anything and allows your provider to investigate the text and take action (if found to be a scam).

If you've lost money, tell your bank and report it as a crime to Action Fraud. By doing this, you'll be helping to prevent others becoming victims of cybercrime.
